

# **Instructions for Filling Out the Delayed Warranty Start Request Form**

Effective December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the Delayed Warranty Start Request Form has been updated. We are now requiring that this <u>Excel Form</u> is utilized for all requests. The form must be filled out electronically. Please see the instructions below for each form.

Note: Customer contact information is not required, please do not provide it.

## **Excel Form**

**Save the file name as the VIN of the vehicle only.
General Motors Delayed Warranty Start Form This form is to be used by U.S. General Motors dealerships and authorized Fleet personnel, after a titled retail delivery has been reported, to extend the start date and/or mileage of a New Vehicle Limited Warranty on eligible vehicles. #### Eligibility Selection

- Please choose one of the corresponding boxes for the type of vehicle that Delayed
   Warranty Start is being requested for.
  - o Commercial Truck Chassis Incomplete or Upfitted Vehicle
  - Recreational Vehicle
    - (Ex. RV, Motorhome)
  - Upfitted Mobility Vehicle
    - (Ex. Ambulance)
  - Coach Vehicle
    - (Ex. Limousines, Flower Cars, and Hearses)
  - Political Subdivision Vehicles (approved by Bid Center)
    - (Ex. Police Vehicles)

#### • Vehicle Information Section

- VIN is 17 characters
- Date: This is the date that the customer/fleet/retailer takes possession of the vehicle for the provided VIN
- Mileage: This should be the odometer reading on the vehicle when the customer takes possession of it.
  - o <u>Important: To be eligible, the vehicle must have less than 3,000 miles and</u> the date must be within two (2) years of the original build date.
- Miles or Kilometers: US-based vehicles should use Miles while Canada-based vehicles should use Kilometers.

#### • Dealer Information Section

- Enter the information for the associated GM Dealership from which the vehicle/chassis was purchased
  - o If you do not have the required information, please contact the dealership.
    - BAC stands for Business Associate Code. It is a 6-digit identifier assigned to the dealership. The dealership BAC should be different than the Fleet BAC.
    - Dealership Name: The name of the dealership that the vehicle/chassis was purchased from
    - Dealer Employee Requestor's Name: The point of contact at the dealer that is either submitting the form or who assisted with the purchase of the vehicle/chassis.

### • Authorized Fleet/Retailer Information

- Requestor's Name: The name of the person sending the request form.
- Requestor's Email: The email of the person sending in the request form.
- Fleet/Retail Business Name:
  - The name of the company selling the vehicle to the customer OR
  - The name of the company the vehicles are being sold to.



- Ex: General RV, a funeral home, a city, an ambulance company, FedEx, Verizon, Comcast, etc.
- Fleet Business Associate Code: This is a 6-digit code assigned to the Fleet by GM.
  - This could be the upfitter or a RV company.
    - o Work with the dealership if a BAC is not available.
- Address: Please include the full address of the Fleet/Retail business provided above.
- Saving the Request Form
  - Use only the 17-character VIN as the file name.
    - $\circ\quad$  This can be copied from the VIN field instead of typing it out again.
  - Attach the now saved file in an email that is to be sent to delayedwarrantystart@qm.com.
